See All the Instances ... See and make changes to open, closed or scheduled Instances. From here, you can also manage packages, as well as planned Instances.

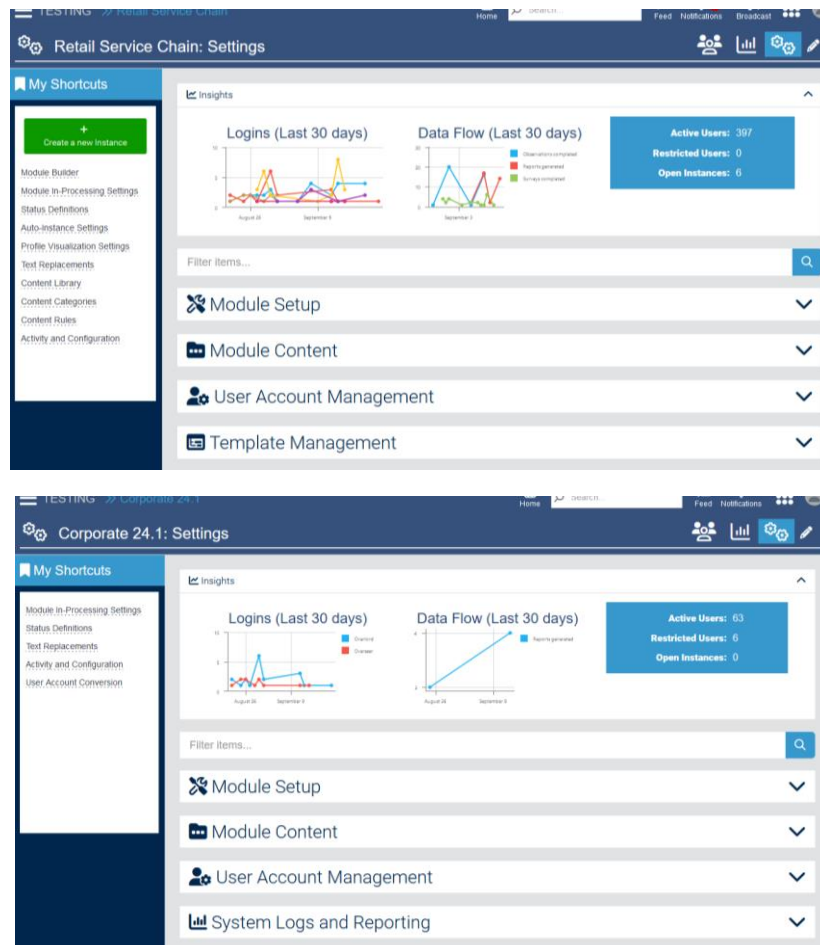

Better Accountability ... GideonSoft now records who changes a person's status as part of the person's status history.

Manage Note Types everywhere ... Just like the Org level and Persistent Modules, you can now manage Note Types in Performance Modules.

Get Your Sheets Together ... Manage spreadsheet availability on the Planner, just like surveys, observations and reports.

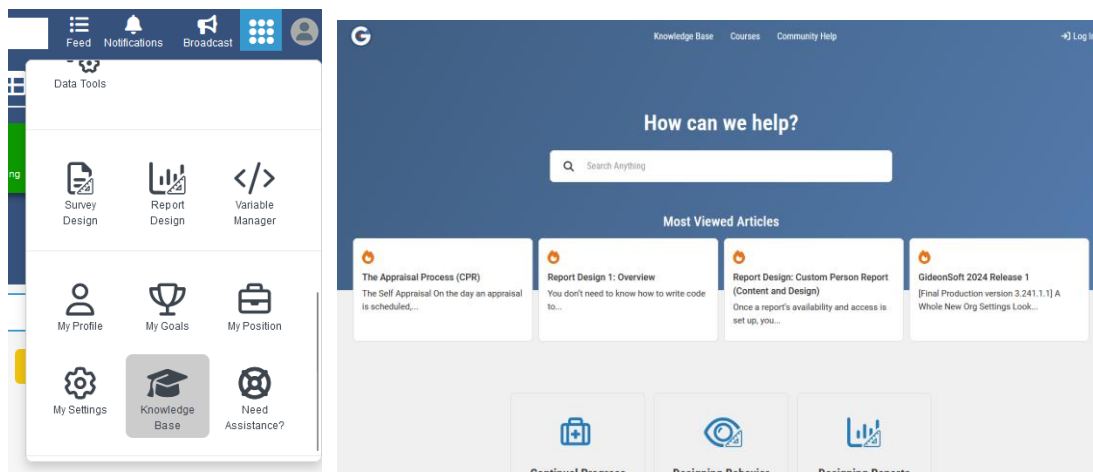
Get Some Help (If You Need It)
